

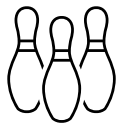
SUMMER READING ASSIGNMENT 2025

Other READING ideas if you wish to improve your English:



- New Boy by Tracy Chevalier

Arriving at his fourth school in six years, Osei needs an ally if he is to survive his first day- so, he's lucky to hit it off with Dee, the most popular girl in school. But one student can't stand to witness this budding relationship and decides to destroy the new friendship between the black boy and the golden girl. By the end of the day, the school and its key players will never be the same again.

- *The Catcher in the Rye* by J.D. Salinger

With the author's death, the classic novel about young Holden Caulfield's disillusionment with the adult world and its "phoniness" will only rise in popularity — and controversy, since it is a favourite target of censors, who often cite profanity and sexual references in their efforts to ban the book.

- *The Secret of Lost Things* by Sheridan Hay

Eighteen-year-old Rosemary leaves her home in Tasmania after her Mum's death to live in New York City and make a fresh start on her own. She is offered a job in a bookshop that sells rare and used books. But when she becomes assistant to the eccentric store manager Walter Geist, she stumbles across a major literary cover-up...
