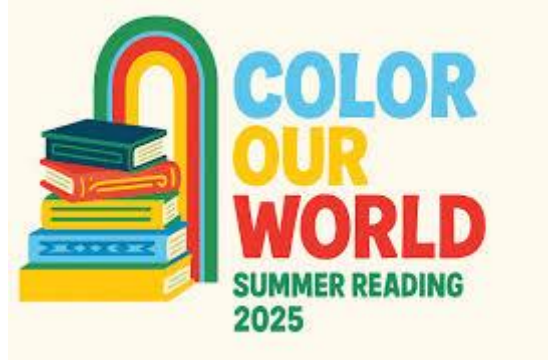


SUMMER READING ASSIGNMENT 2025

- *His Dark Materials Series* by Philip Pullman (fantasy)
- *Earthsea Series* by Ursula Le Guin (fantasy)
- *Anne Of Green Gables* by Lucy Maud Montgomery (coming of age, family and friends)
- *In Memoriam* by Alice Winn (WWI, LGBTQ+)
- *Last Night Telegraph Club* by Malinda Lo (LGBTQ+, historical fiction)
